LEAD VOLUNTEER

A Lead Volunteer supports the **Road To Recovery** program by **engaging, assisting, and/or recruiting drivers**. The specific commitments vary depending on the volunteer and needs of the area.

All roles are not required.

MENTOR - OUTREACH

Assist ACS with increasing rides provided & driver participation.
 Review rides available. Contact drivers to encourage acceptance
Check on drivers who have not driven recently.
 Help drivers with Roundtrip questions. Troubleshoot duplicates.
Welcome new drivers.
Communicate driver feedback to ACS staff partner.
Gather photos, videos, & testimonials.
Help staff partner with volunteer appreciation & recognition.
PROMOTION - RECRUITMENT
Brainstorm driver recruitment channels, audiences, groups, etc.
Disseminate recruitment flyers, cards, & other resources.
Be a spokesperson for local presentations & media interviews.
Network to share volunteer needs to community groups.
Promote the program to connect more people needing rides.

REQUIREMENTS

- Age 18+
- Comfort using technology (websites, email)
- Timely communication with drivers and staff partner
- Enjoy calling and emailing drivers (depending on role)
- Respect diversity of patients, volunteers, and staff
- Follow program guidelines and policies
- Complete online driver training
- Passion for helping people with cancer, volunteers, & ACS
- Those interested in driving also comply with driver requirements
